

Chai Black

Inspired by travels to India sourcing tea; chai black is a sweet aromatic blend that helps keep out the cold. Created by combining premium black tea and an assortment of traditional spices.

Cloud Catcher

Cloud Catcher is a colourful fruit blend designed to brighten up those grey days. The natural sweetness of apple is pleasantly complemented by the slight tartness of cranberry in this naturally caffeine free infusion.

Earl Grey

Traditionally a blend of black teas with added bergamot flavouring; this Earl Grey is hand-crafted using the finest Chinese and Indian black teas with an added sprinkle of blue cornflowers and natural flavourings.

Golden Osmanthus Oolong (Huang Jin Gui)

Golden Osmanthus takes its name from the golden liquor of the infusion, of its yellow green leaves and for its distinct osmanthus flower-like aroma. This oolong has a sweet floral flavour with a hint of honeysuckle.

Highland Rooibos

Highland Rooibos combines South African Rooibos with flavours picked from Scotland's wilderness. It creates a refreshing caffeine-free infusion that calls to mind a crisp Highland morning shrouded in mist.

Jasmine Dragon Pearl

Jasmine Dragon Pearl is picked in the early spring in the misty mountains of Fujian province. Only the most tender green buds and select leaves are hand rolled into small pearls. The leaves are then scented naturally with jasmine.

Leith Lights

A caffeine free blend inspired by the ornate street lamps of Leith. Leith Lights brings together invigorating ingredients with turmeric and juicy tropical natural flavours.

Peppermint

Peppermint tea is a naturally caffeine free infusion made from the leaves of the peppermint plant. Our peppermint is a cut leaf and makes a very refreshing infusion.

Rose Gin Tea

A unique and delightful blend of black tea, rose and gin botanicals that create a taste profile reminiscent of the classic gin and tonic cocktail. Hand blended in Edinburgh this fragrant blend is sure to impress any tea lover looking to try something new and exciting.
